3. Draw a rime (word family ending) card.
4. Write as many different words as you can by adding an onset (a letter/sound to the beginning.
5. For example, if you pick the ending $\qquad$ $a t$, you could add a "b" and make "bat", a "c" and make "cat", an " $f$ " and make "fat", or an " $h$ " and make "hat".
6. Write as many words as you can with each rime (word ending).
7. Then draw another rime (word ending) card, and begin again.
8. Practice will make you better and better at this.

## Directions:
