5. Game can be played alone.



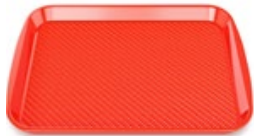

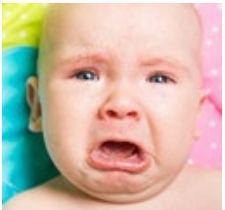
