

## Pronoun Plus Language Arts Activity for 2<sup>nd</sup>Grade

## **Pronoun Plus**

**Purpose:** The purpose of this game is to help students practice replacing nouns with the correct pronouns.

## **Materials:**

Print the pronoun cards below and cut them apart.

her	his	mine	my
your	our	their	them
her	his	mine	my
your	our	their	them

Make copies of the sentence cards below and cut them apart.

Joe put on <u>Joe's</u> cap.	"Sally found book," said Nancy.
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Lisa got <u>Carla's</u> purse.	The children and I play on this team. This isteam.
"That cat is," I said.	I wish I could go to <u>Sally's</u> and <u>Marni's</u> party.
Washing clothes is <u>John's</u> job," said John.	The toys belong to <u>Jorge</u> , <u>Fred</u> , and <u>John</u> .
Here is Julie's pencil. It is pencil.	May I have attention please?
Joe's mom took him to the ball game.	Laura, Clara and I share this room. This isroom.

Those flowers belong to me. They're	Greg knew <u>Tom's and</u> <u>Robert's</u> plans.
I live in that house on top of the hill. It is house.	These pictures belong to Betty, Patsy and Tim.

## **Directions:**

- 1. Lay the pronoun cards face up on a 4 by 4 grid.
- 2. Shuffle the sentence cards and turn them face down.
- 3. First player draws a sentence card and selects the correct pronoun that will replace the underlined nouns.
- 4. Player has approximately 30 seconds to determine which pronoun completes the sentence correctly.
- 5. If player succeeds in less than 30 seconds, then he/she earns 3 points; if more that 30 seconds, the player does earns 1 point.
- 6. When all pronouns and sentences are matched, the player with the greatest number of points, wins.
