Directions:

1. Lay the pronoun cards face up on a 4 by 4 grid.
2. Shuffle the sentence cards and turn them face down.
3. First player draws a sentence card and selects the correct pronoun that will replace the underlined nouns.
4. Player has approximately 30 seconds to determine which pronoun completes the sentence correctly.
5. If player succeeds in less than 30 seconds, then he/she earns 3 points; if more than 30 seconds, the player does not earn 1 point.
6. When all pronouns and sentences are matched, the player with the greatest number of points, wins.
