

Concentration—Singular and Plurals Language Arts Activity for 3rd Grade

Concentration

Purpose: The purpose of this game is to help students practice the plurals of words that end in "consonant + y".

Materials:

Print the cards below on card stock. You will find the root word and the plural of that word.

Directions:

- 1. This game can be played with up to 4 players.
- 2. Shuffle the deck of cards.
- 3. Create a 5 by 5 grid of cards with the word face down.
- 4. Player 1 turns over two cards. If the cards match (the singular of the word and the plural of the same word—cry and cries) then the player picks up the match and those cards are kept and the player continues his/her turn.
- 5. After each player's turn is complete, if a match has been found, additional cards from the deck are added to the grid, "word down" until there are now cards left in the deck.
- 6. If player 1 does not find a match, then it is the turn of player 2.
- 7. Play continues until all cards are matched. Player with the most cards wins.
