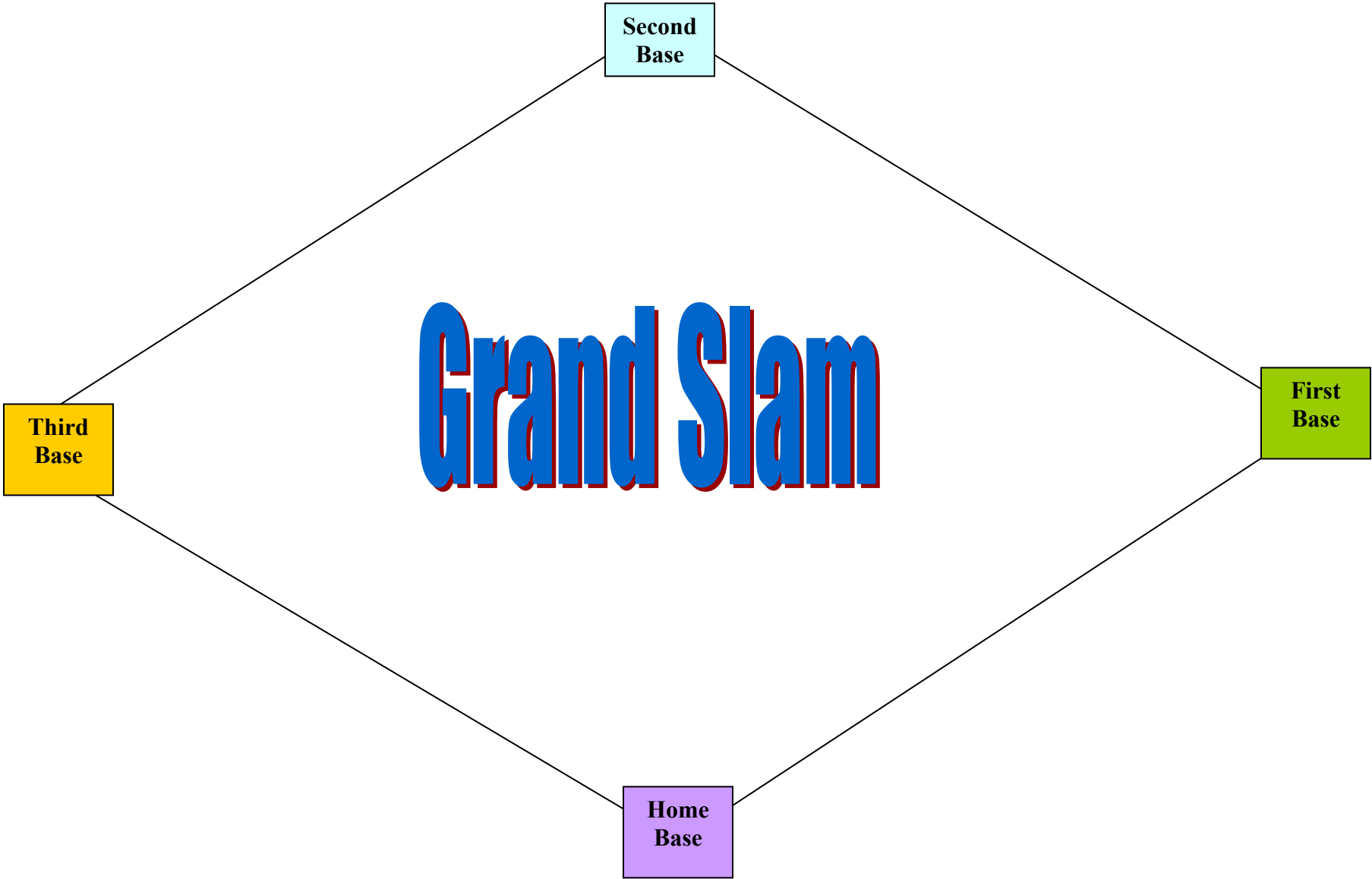


DIRECTIONS:

Example: Fence
